WHAT IS EWAC?



A key international awareness week on the health calendar, the European week Against Cancer (EWAC) takes place every year between 25 and 31 May to unite Europe in the fight against cancer.

EWAC is organised by the <u>Association of Cancer Leagues (ECL)</u>, in collaboration with its member leagues and partners across Europe. During EWAC, all public, private and non-profit organisations in the cancer community are encouraged to organise virtual events, promote relevant publications and projects, as well as make use of our communication materials.

WHAT ECL WANTS ACHIEVE DURING #EWAC2023?

In 2023, ECL's EWAC campaign will highlight and focus on the future of cancer prevention in Europe and the role the European Code Against Cancer (ECAC) and Europe's Beating Cancer Plan (#EUCancer Plan) play in cancer prevention, screening, treatment and survivorship.

During #EWAC2023, ECL will:

- raise awareness about the initiatives and actions of <u>Europe's</u>
 <u>Beating Cancer Plan (EBCP)</u> and <u>the European Code Against Cancer (ECAC)</u>
- reflect on progress and the role that each one of us has in promotion and the implementation of the Cancer Plan.
- promote the recommendations of cancer leagues to ensure that the successful implementation of the EBCP.
