- Supporting the creation of **world-class cancer centres** in every EU country to ensure collaboration and address rare cancer cases.
- Ensuring treatments are affordable by promoting **joint EU procurement** of cutting-edge cancer treatments.
- Strengthening care standards through harmonised training for healthcare professionals and the development of EU-wide guidelines.
